

**Annual Members Meeting**  
**Saturday June 29, 2002**

Members present: Frank Johnson, Scott Counce, PK Snead, Bill Culberth, Jim Berry, Martha Jo Berry, Hewlett Sullivan, Adam Hewitt, Len Taylor, Scott Luna, Ron Springs, Alan Sanders, and Jackson Norton.

PK Snead opened the meeting in prayer. No Officer Report was given by Alan Sanders (Chairman of the Board), Hewlett Sullivan (Vice President), or Adam Hewitt (Secretary). Jackson Norton (President/Director) discussed the difficulty of obtaining the technology for on-line payments, and message boards through the website.

Chapel Committee had no report. Bill Culberth (Fundraising Chairman) spoke about the fundraising meeting and its general direction. Bill mentioned that he was recently appointed Committee Chairman by outgoing Chairman of the Board Alan Sanders and that the committee had decided to have a phon-a-thon and a catered dinner with a fundraising meeting in conjunction with the fall work-weekend. The fundraising agenda was approved by the Board.

Frank Johnson (Reunion Chairman) spoke about his wish to eliminate the spring work-weekend and just have the fall work-weekend, similar to Camp Crestridge's Maintain the Memories weekend. The Members rejected this idea after much debate and stated that would be held July 24-27<sup>th</sup>, 2003. The Board approved this idea but did not assign a person in charge. Alan Sanders appointed Bill Culberth as Co-Chairman with Frank Johnson on the 75<sup>th</sup> Summer Celebration/Homecoming. The Board requested that a generational chairman for each camp decade be selected by the Co-Chairman of the Reunion Committee. The Board decided to approach the Conference Center to get a tram to help shuttle people from parking areas to the camp to reduce the congestion during the event. Discussion turned to having someone on staff next summer to help coordinate the alumni event. Board asked Jackson (Director) to facilitate that with Camp Ridgecrest.

Discussion turned to old business. Nominees at the winter Board of Directors meeting were, Paul Grass, John Carey, Landis Stanfield, Dan Pierce, John Suggs, David and Susan Bell, Hal Unwin, and Scott Luna. Bill Culberth called the question after discussion. Motion passed unanimously that the nominees be elected to the Board of Directors.

Jackson moved to close the meeting which was seconded by Hewlett Sullivan. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
