

Minutes of July 27, 2003
Meeting of the Membership of
Camp Ridgecrest Alumni & Friends, Inc.

Steve Little called the meeting was called to order and Richmond Stroupe opened with prayer. Since the minutes were on the website the membership agreed to dispense with reading of the minutes.

Eight names were presented for nomination for seven spots on the Board: Rick Jones, Jacob Driggers, Dick Burts, Jason Hall, Adam Underwood, Matt Brown, Beth Olson and George Shriver. Dick Burts and Beth Olson offered to drop their names from nomination, but the group felt that their membership was crucial. After some discussion, it was suggested that all be elected currently except Adam Underwood who would be put on a list for election at the winter meeting for next year. This slate was approved.

Frank Johnson presented a committee report on the reunion and indicated that we would start work soon on the 80th anniversary. He noted that e-mail lists are available on request. The membership recognized Frank Johnson for his work on the reunion.

Scott Luna presented a Treasurer's report, indicating that, before the alumni reunion weekend, there were assets approximating \$114,000 and over \$101,000 in the chapel fund. He noted that both the assets were invested in investment grade bonds with staggered maturities.

It was reported that Crestridge would have their 50th anniversary next year and noted that Steve would appoint a volunteer committee to find a gift to give to the Crestridge organization with a budget of \$500. A motion was made and seconded that this money be approved for that purpose and the motion passed unanimously.

The chapel committee reported on the expected cost of the chapel and that the chapel committee would be back in action once the fund-raising was completed. It was noted that the fundraising committee was still at work. A solicitation was made for the names individuals with construction experience who might be helpful in reducing the cost of construction of the chapel.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
